I Have Been Set Free Ephesians 1:7

Redemption or freedom is available in Jesus. Understanding and applying this truth results in victory over guilt.

- Roman redemption is a picture of spiritual freedom
- We're spiritual slaves needing redemption
 - God requires:
 - Perfection (1 Peter 1:16)
 - Penalty (2 Thessalonians 1:9)
 - We have provided neither
- We have a redeemer in Jesus
 - Jesus meet four qualifications:
 - Is a relative (Galatians 4:4)
 - Is willing (John 10:18)
 - Doesn't need redemption (John 8:34;Hebrews 4:15)
 - Able to pay the ransom (2Thessalonians 1:9; John 1:1)
- Jesus paid a ransom with His blood

- 3 terms help explain the ransom:
 - Substitution (Isaiah 53:6)
 - Propitiation (1 John 2:2)
 - Perfection (1 Peter 1:19)
 - Penalty (Isaiah 53:1-11)
 - Bore Sin (1 Peter 2:24)
 - Became Sin (2 Corinthians 5:21)
 - Identification (In Him)
- We're to walk in gracious forgiveness or freedom as a result of redemption
